There are volunteering opportunities for anyone from the age of 16 to 65+.

It is an opportunity to explore vocation and calling to ministry with and alongside Children, Youth and Young adults. There are a variety of roles to be filled and an opportunity to be a part of a large Methodist event which focuses on hearing and responding to the voices of children and young people across the Connexion.

The Volunteer teams consist of 3 main categories:

Venue/programme teams-who work within each of the venues to manage the setup of the venue space for the programming in this venue and to be a support to those facilitating sessions in the Venues.

Care teams- who are focussed on supporting participants and sometimes their leaders. Such as the Roving Youth, Chalet Hosts, Additional Needs and Night Stewards.

Logistics Team - include face to face roles such as reception, Merchandising and Stewarding, practical roles such as the set-up venue and take-down.
